Applicants who are normally resident in Northern Ireland and are members of the London Mathematical Society (LMS) are entitled to choose whether to pay either the normal annual subscription of the LMS and pay an annual subscription to the IMS equal to one-half of the normal IMS annual subscription or the normal annual subscription of the IMS and pay an annual subscription to the LMS equal to one-half of the normal LMS annual subscription.
